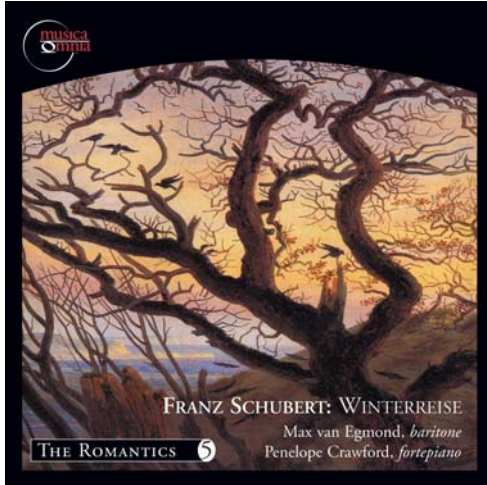




New Compact Disc Release

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Franz Schubert Winterreise, D. 911

"I like these songs better than all the others and some day you will too". In 1828, with these words, Franz Schubert responded to his friends who found his new song cycle, Winterreise, impossibly gloomy and bleak. Schubert's second and final essay in this genre, based, like Die schöne Müllerin from five years earlier, on poems by Wilhelm Müller stands as the greatest Lieder cycle of all time. Max van Egmond and Penelope Crawford continue their great collaboration with a performance for the ages.
