



Felix Mendelssohn: Piano Trio in D minor, Op. 49 Piano Sextet in D major, Op. 110*

This second release devoted to the chamber works with fortepiano by Felix Mendelssohn is performed on instruments of the period. The early Piano Sextet Op.(posth.) 110 dating from 1824 when Felix was just 15 years old is paired with the beautiful and familiar Piano Trio in D minor, Op. 49, from 1839. Fortepianist Penelope Crawford is joined by her long-time Atlantis colleagues, Jaap Schröder and cellist Enid Sutherland in Op. 49, the trio augmented by Peter Bucknell and Daniel Foster (violas) and Anne Trout (double bass) in the sextet.
